Managed by the Price Lab, the minor in digital humanities is an attractive option for English majors who would like to experiment with emerging technologies and data-driven research. Our students learn how technology can enhance humanities research and how critical humanistic concerns around meaning, power, and identity can be brought to bear on an increasingly digital culture. As a minor in DH, you'll develop both the technical know-how and the critical-humanistic perspectives to do original research and prepare for a wide range of careers.

The minor is designed to complement all concentrations across the English major, including creative writing and cinema studies. There are no prerequisites and no prior technical experience is required.
